reproducing, binding instructions for score and parts

Score and parts are ready to be printed back-to-back, and bound on the left edge.

The flugelhorn part is also set up to be reproduced back-to-back, but the process to reach that goal is more complicated. Pages of the eventual part are in pairs, with page numbers at the top of each large page. There will be four large pages when completed, producing only one page turn. Instructions:

- 1. Print the part on single sides of 8.5 by 11 paper.
- 2. Using 11 by 17 blank paper, tape the pages in sequence so that the second of each pair per page is at the bottom of a large sheet. (The title/instruction page will be the only printed page on a large sheet.) The part's page number will end up at the top, with a few extra inches of space at the top.
- 3. Photocopy the resulting five pages back-to-back onto heavy stock 11 x 17 paper.
- 4. Align the pages well, and trim the excess paper from the top of all pages at once.
- 5. Bind on the left edge.
